STATUTES

I- Purpose and composition of the association

Article 1

In accordance with the Code of Civil and Commercial Obligations, a non-profit association called the Senegalese Chapter of the Internet Society known as Isoc-Senegal is established in Dakar (Senegal) between the members of the present statutes. The Senegalese Chapter of the Internet Society is intended to constitute the Senegalese branch of the Internet Society, abbreviated by the acronym Isoc, which is an association of American law whose seat is in the United States

Article 2

The purpose of the Senegalese Chapter of Isoc is:

Promote the use of the Internet in Senegal by highlighting the experiences gained, providing a first level of information and promoting contacts between members and with other Isoc members;

Encourage Senegalese participation in Isoc's work;

To encourage participation in all types of cooperative projects, whether Senegal or international, of a private or public nature;

Promote adequate treatment of national languages on the Internet, encourage the circulation of local content and foster cooperation with other African Chapters of the Isoc;

To make the positions of the Chapter and the Isoc known to all natural or legal persons interested on the Internet;

To prepare and participate in any formal or informal meetings, demonstrations, conferences, working groups or commissions, as well as any work or publication, whether or not using electronic means, in particular the Internet, in conformity with its corporate purpose.

To undertake all activities aimed at creating an enabling environment, democratizing access and generally promoting the Internet in Senegal.

Article 3

The use of the name Senegalese Chapter of Isoc is subject to the obtaining of a protocol agreement with Isoc and its ratification by the general assembly by a two-thirds majority. The non-validation or denunciation of the protocol entails a change of name of the Association.

Article 4

The association has its headquarters at Cheikh Anta Diop University in Dakar. It may be transferred to any other place in the Senegalese territory, by simple decision of the Steering Committee. The duration of the association is unlimited.

Article 5

The Senegalese Chapter of Isoc is composed of natural or legal persons. To become a member, it is necessary to have requested it from the Steering Committee and to accept the statutes and the internal rules of the Chapter. All members of the Isoc Senegalese Chapter must also be members of the Internet Society. Membership is subject to the payment of an annual membership fee. This contribution includes a part corresponding to the Isoc contribution and a part corresponding to the specific contribution of the association, the amount of which is fixed annually by the Steering Committee. Membership is not mandatory to participate in Isoc or Chapter activities. The Executive Committee may award honorary membership to natural or legal persons.

Article 6

Membership of the Isocal Senegalese Chapter is lost by:

resignation ;

Non-payment of the membership fee;

The cancellation pronounced by the general assembly on the proposal of the Steering Committee. The member concerned shall first be called upon to provide his explanations.

II- Resources

Article 7

The resources of the association are as follows:

Of the contribution portion of the association, the portion of the contribution being repaid to the association;

Gifts and bequests;

In general, from any other resource which it may legally dispose of.

III- Administration and operation

Article 8

The General Assembly of the Association shall be composed of all up-to-date members of their dues. It shall meet at least once a year and at each convening of the Steering Committee or upon written request of two thirds (2/3) of the members Of the association addressed to the President. It elects a Steering Committee. It receives a report on the management of the Steering Committee and on the moral and financial situation of the association. It approves the accounts for the financial year closed, votes the budget for the following financial year and deliberates on the items on the agenda. Each member of the association, whether natural or legal person, shall have one vote.

Article 9

The Association is administered by a Steering Committee of fifteen (15) members elected by the General Assembly for a period of one year. The election of the Steering Committee is organized by an electoral committee. It is constituted under the responsibility of the member having the greatest seniority in the association or, in case of equality between several members, the member with the longest seniority in the Isoc. The committee shall draw up a

list of candidates, each of which shall include a brief summary of its activities and of the actions it undertakes to promote within the Association. The Committee may decide that all or part of the electoral operations shall be carried out by electronic means, in particular as regards the distribution of the list of candidates, their profession of faith, the practical conduct of voting and the announcement of the results . Elections to the Steering Committee shall be by a vote of the current members of their dues. The fifteen (15) candidates with the highest number of votes shall be declared elected. In the event of a tie, the youngest candidate is selected. Members of the Steering Committee shall be eligible for re-election.

Article 10

The Steering Committee shall meet at least once a month, convened by its Chairman, or at the request of a majority of its members. The participation of two thirds (2/3) of the members of the Steering Committee is necessary for the validity of the deliberations. Decisions shall be taken by a majority vote. In the event of a tie, the President shall have the casting vote. Any member of the Steering Committee who, without excuse, has not participated in three consecutive sessions, may be considered as having resigned. The organization and conduct of each session may involve all or part of the electronic means, including the announcement of the session, deliberations, decision-making, recording and publicity of decisions taken. In the event of a vacancy, the Steering Committee provisionally provides for the replacement of its members. They shall be replaced by a vote at the next meeting of the General Assembly. The powers of the members so elected shall end at the time when the term of office of the replaced members should normally expire.

Article 11

The Executive Committee shall elect from among its members an Executive Board composed of five (5) members:

A president

A vice-president

A general secretary

A Treasurer

An Assistant Treasurer

In the event of a vacancy, the Executive Board provisionally provides for the replacement of its members. They shall be replaced by a vote at the next meeting of the Steering Committee. The powers of the members so elected shall end at the time when the term of office of the replaced members should normally expire.

Article 12

The President is the legal person of the association and is responsible for the conduct of the Chapter and the management of its activities in accordance with the policy and procedures of the Internet Society and its texts. The President shall preside over the meetings of the Chapter, the Steering Committee and the Executive Board. In case of incapacity, he may delegate this function to another member of the Executive Board. He is also the expenditure authorizing officer.

The Vice-President shall assist and deputize the President in case of necessity.

The Secretary-General shall keep minutes of all meetings of the Chapter, the Executive Committee and the Executive Board. Other duties include:

The drafting of the annual activity report of the Chapter to be presented to the General Assembly for adoption,

The transmission of the annual activity report adopted by the General Assembly at Isoc (Document 94-253);

The notification to the Isoc of any change in the elected organs of the Chapter and the information of its officials.

The Treasurer collects dues, executes expenditure orders and maintains the Chapter's financial statements. His duties also include:

The preparation of draft budgets submitted to the Executive Board,

The preparation of the annual financial report of the Chapter for adoption by the General Assembly and its transmission to the Isoc.

The Assistant Treasurer shall assist and supplement the Treasurer if necessary.

Article 13

The Executive Board implements the main orientations defined by the Steering Committee, to which it reports on its activities. It shall meet whenever necessary at the call of its chairman.

Article 14

Apart from the members of the Board of Directors, the General Assembly appoints two (2) auditors to examine the financial reports submitted by the Treasurer General.

Article 15

The Chapter shall hold its meetings in open and accessible places for all members of the Internet Society. Notification of the place and time of all meetings shall be communicated to members at least one week in advance by e-mail, orally, telegraphically or by other written means.

IV- Rules of procedure, amendment of the statutes and dissolution

Article 16

The statutes may be amended only on the proposal of the Steering Committee or two thirds (2/3) of the members up to date of their contributions. The text of the amendments must be communicated to the members of the General Assembly at least fifteen (15) days before the date of the meeting. The session of the Assembly shall be attended by at least two-thirds of the members in office. If this proportion is not reached, a new session shall be prepared, at least fifteen days apart. In all cases, the articles of association may only be modified by a two-thirds (2/3) majority of the members present.

Article 17

In the event of dissolution by at least two-thirds (2/3) of the members present at the meeting, the assets, if any, are vested in an association pursuing the same objectives.

Article 18

The by-laws of the Association supplement the provisions of these Statutes.
