

Format Draft ccNSO Council Statement

The ccNSO Council welcomes the opportunity to provide feed-back and comment on the proposed IANA Naming Functions Agreement.

The comments below have been considered and endorsed by the ccNSO Council, though do not necessarily represent the consensus view of ccNSO members or other ccTLDs, some of whom may decide to submit their own comments.

General Comments

The ccTLDs operators will be direct customers of the naming services. As such they have a clear and specific interest in the IANA naming functions agreement. The ccNSO Council is aware of the comments made by representatives of ccTLDs on the CWG-Stewardship and to the extent they have already been accepted by all involved, trusts they will be incorporated before the Agreement becomes effective.

Specific comments

The ccNSO Council recommends that the following changes are made to the proposed agreement:

SECTION 4.7

2. The reference to the GAC Principles should read: "Where applicable in accordance with Section 1.3 thereof, the 2005 Governmental Advisory Committee Principles and Guidelines for the Delegation and Administration of Country Code Top Level Domains ("GAC 2005 ccTLD Principles").
