UASG Coordination WG Meeting on July 13

Agenda Item B: Reviewing the Public Comments about the Draft FY24 Action Plan

There are in total 6 comments from the community on the FY24 Action Plan. The Coordination WG reviewed these comments and addressed them based on the consensus. No changes were made where the suggested edits are not impactful, or require comprehensive changes on other things.
