### Proposed for ccNSO appointment to ICANN's Nominating Committee

**Nigel Roberts** is CEO of the Island Networks organisation which runs the .GG and .JE ccTLDs.

He is also a partner in Roberts Lane LLP, a domain name law and business consultancy. He is a principal consultant to TLD Registry Services LLC, a technical advisory company that provides expertise to small and medium sized registries on registry operations using the CoCCA Registry and risk management services.

**Nigel Roberts** was part of the ccTLD community during the US Government's *Interational Forum on the White Paper* in 1998-99 which led to the creation of ICANN.

He has been an active member of the ccTLD and ICANN communities since then, attending over 35 ICANN meetings to date.

Pursuing an engineering formation, he graduated from the University of Essex at Colchester (UK) with a first degree (BSc) in Computer Science.

In 1991 Nigel was awarded both Chartered Engineer (UK) and European Engineer (Eur. Ing) status.

In 2006 he became a Fellow of the BCS (Britain's *Chartered Institute for IT*), and in 2008 he completed law school, gaining a Qualifying Law Degree (the academic requirement to practice law in England & Wales) with first-class honours.

He was previously a member of the DNSO Council (today's ccNSO Council and DNSO Council together).

He lives at Alderney, in the Bailiwick of Guernsey, British Channel Islands, where he was previously a member of the Island's Parliament ("*Les Etats*").
