**Getting the APAC hub off the ground** – The APAC hub is now a reality, with a physical office in the city, as well as open communication channels for local stakeholders to access ICANN staff.

Currently, the office has four staff - two in the regional GSE team (Kuek and Jiarong), an operations manager (Linda) and a facilitator (Philadel) for the entire region. We have a registry manager (Han Chuan) and the head of China (Song Zheng) joining in October. Together with Save and Terry in Brisbane,

we have 8 confirmed staff in the region and more in the pipeline. Such moves underscore ICANN's commitment to the region and we look forward to closer interaction with the regional community to see how we can better meet the needs on the ground.

## Youth for Information Technology – Y4IT in Manila, Philippines



The 11th Philippine Youth Congress on Information Technology (Y4IT) was held from 17-19 September in Manila.

This year's run saw the biggest turnout in the history of the Y4IT – a total of 25,000, with some 10,000 participants sitting in the sessions each day. Attendees were mostly IT students from not only Manila, but all over the Philippines and the organisers partnered most of the higher learning IT institutions to participate. It was described as an 'IT rock party'.

APAC Head of Strategy and Initiatives, Low Jia Rong, made a keynote speech on ICANN and its multi-stakeholder model, as well as the importance of Asia and ICANN's commitment to the region.
