My name is Ondrej Filip, I am a CEO at CZ.NIC – ccTLD manager of .cz. I would like to volunteer to the AoC Review Team for Security, Stability and Resilience of the DNS. I believe I have enough qualification to serve the global community in such important process.

I have been working in TLD business since 2004. One of the key tasks of every TLD registry is to ensure a secure, stable and resilient operation of its part of the DNS system. In order to improve the security of the local domain .cz me and my colleagues at CZ.NIC have implemented DNSSEC technology in 2008 as one of the earliest implementers. We have implemented several policies and procedures to address many potential threats of our registrants and registrars and .cz domain users. Outcomes of such acts are for example end user level domain name blocking; establishing of our security department CZ.NIC CERT or security focused part of R&D program called CZ.NIC Labs.

Of course, we are not just focused on the domain .cz and Czech users. We are also involved in many international activities and forums related to DNS security, stability and resilience. We (including me personally) are active participants of DNS-OARC, CENTR tech and other DNS related activities. As a developed and stable registry, we realize we have a responsibility towards less developed registries that are lacking resources and need a help to be able to ensure its operation including DNS. To address this issue, we have developed and free, open-source registry system that currently allows some of the smaller registries to provide its services securely and steadily.

Last but not least, we realize the importance and a key role of ICANN in the enhancement the operational stability, reliability, resilience, and global interoperability of DNS. We would like to help to improve this issue. And that is the main reason I would like to volunteer to this AoC Review Team.
