ccNSO Appointed Member on ICANN's NomCom 2022

Dear Joke

I would like to volunteer for the upcoming ccNSO vacancy on the NomCom.

I think this particular position offers an opportunity to advance the ccNSO agenda within ICANN, by influencing the nomination process within the Committee.

I am unaware, however, of previous incumbents having solicited input in this regard from membership nor ever having provided feedback in any form to membership after their appointments. While I do not know whether this holds true for Council I firmly believe that this should be done.

I myself do not hold firm positions which skill sets are currently required on the 4 structures to which NomCom is to appoint this year but would endeavor to solicit input from membership and Council and abide by them during NomCom deliberations, if appointed.

While committing to NonCom's confidentiality I would propose to set up a regular session on each ccNSO Public Meeting to report back on the status of the deliberations. This could be perhaps done together with the ccNSO Liaisons to the other SO/ACs, something I have mentioned in passing already in Johannesburg.

I believe I am a suitable candidate since I have insight into the technological, operational, administrative, logistical and policy (in particular multi-stakeholder) aspects of ICANN, while at the same time being an experienced ccTLD Manager with a wide network of contacts.

My participation on previous and current Working Groups, has shown that I not only base my work on consensus, but also try to represent the interests of the membership (over my own) to the best of my ability.

Fortunately due to being in private practice I am in full control of my workload which and have been able to schedule it around my ICANN commitments, both as far as conference calls and travel have been concerned (in 2015 I managed all in all 8 international trips).

TechDay would not be affected, as most work is the solicitation of speakers and arranging the

agenda by the Program Committee which happens mainly by email. Should the actual Tech-Day conflict with NomCom deliberations, the moderation can be taken over by any number of members of the Working Group.

The Retirement PDP would also not be affected unless the NomCom manages to conflict with out alternating Wednesday 20:00 UTC schedule, and at the same Stephen Deerhake and Bart Boswinkel as the Chair and Issue Manager, respectively, were both unavailable at the same time. If PDP Face to Face meetings were to conflict with NomCom Face to Face meetings, the NomCom would enjoy priority.
