1. Currently Actions

3. ITU activities being watched

A. ITU's EG-ITRs group:

- the ITU (pursuant to a decision of the 2014 Plenipotentiary) has established an Expert Group to look at a potential revision to the ITRs adopted in 2012.
- ICANN plans to attend the initial meeting to be held Feb. 9/10 in Geneva
- The group plans to discuss the following items
 - ① an examination of the 2012 ITRs to determine its applicability in a rapidly evolving international telecommunication environment, taking into account technology, services and existing multilateral and international legal obligations as well as changes in the scope of domestic regulatory regimes;
 - ② Legal analyses of the 2012 ITRs;
 - ③ Analyses of any potential conflicts between the obligations of signatories to the 2012 ITRs and signatories to the 1988 ITRs with respect to implementation of the provisions of the 1988 and the 2012 ITRs.

B. ICANN's submission to ITU's open consultation on the "Developmental Aspects of the Internet" (File attached)

- ✓ Following the instruction of the Plenipotentiary Conference 2014, ITU Council revised its [Resolution 1344 \(Mod. 2015\)](#) resolving that the [CWG-Internet](#) should hold both open online consultation and physical open consultation meetings, with remote participation, within a defined period prior to each CWG-Internet meeting.
