

Monthly report of UASG work

September 2023

UASG Coordination WG Meeting on August 9

The new UASG leadership team has been actively engaged since its formation, and this month the UASG WG updates the following progress:

Agenda Item A: FY23 UA Readiness Report.

Complete FY23 UA Readiness Report, submit a working group to ask their community, this month to determine the draft released on the 26th of this month (<https://uasg.tech/download/uasg-047-ua-readiness-report-fy23/>).

Agenda Item B: UASG 5-year action plan

UASG Leadership Team drafted the “Five-Year Strategic Plan for UASG” in achieving UA goals, analyze the current achievements of UA, describe UASG 5-year strategic plan and timetable, and specify 5-year long-term goals and 3-year short-term goals in groups, which are currently consulted by the community. The plan will be further consulted to the community at a dedicated session at ICANN78.

Agenda Item C: EAI Self Certification Guide.

EAI WG has been completed EAI Self Certification Guide, which are currently consulted by the community.

Agenda Item D: UASG Coordination WG Meeting on September 6.

1.UASG Governance

Regarding the internal governance of the UASG, one of the solutions discussed by the leadership team at the Istanbul meeting was to provide a public Statement of Interest (SOI) for voting members, a topic that was discussed at length by the Working Group, with Chairman Anil recommending a unanimous agreement to establish SOI for leadership positions and working group members, while ensuring that security issues are addressed.

2. UASG Structure and WGs

This review focused on UA work and proposed the establishment of regular groups for Global UA Day activities, as well as the establishment of a sub-group from the Coordination Working Group in order to promote cooperation with governments in UA focus areas. After a heated discussion, consensus was reached that the task of "Government involvement in UA" was assigned to the UA Coordination Working Group, and in the interim, the task of "Planning a Global UA Day" was assigned to the UA Communications Working Group.

3. SO/AC liaison Roles

UASG has increased contact with ccNSO, GNSO, GAC, ALAC and other organizations through various focal points, and encourages members to continue to provide feedback and topic discussions.
