Project Background


- 2013 Registrar Accreditation Agreement included new, but limited, requirements for privacy and proxy service providers
- 2013 RAA requirements in place, pending policy development to create new accreditation program
- ICANN Board approved Final Recommendations in Aug. 2016

Implementation Efforts to Date





Deliverables Status

- Policy: First review complete; IRT will complete second review after completing review of draft contract, prior to posting for public comment
- Accreditation Agreement: IRT began reviewing in July; IRT review expected to be complete in late November/early December
- Application/Accreditation Processes: IRT has reviewed draft application and accreditation process
- De-Accreditation Process: IRT has reviewed deaccreditation proposal



Overview: Proposed Accreditation Program



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- Proposed accreditation program is modeled on registrar accreditation program
- Once program is launched, registrars must not knowingly accept registrations involving a privacy and/or proxy service from an unaccredited provider
- Providers must submit an application for accreditation and will be evaluated for capability and willingness to comply with program requirements
- ICANN-managed compliance program
- For providers that are affiliated with registrars, some requirements may be met through affiliated registrar (e.g. data escrow, data retention)



Overview: Accreditation Program Requirements

- Applicants for accreditation must:
 - Complete provider educational program;
 - Undergo due diligence screening; and
 - Demonstrate understanding of policy and contractual requirements related to:
 - Terms of service and other notices to customers and third parties;
 - Law Enforcement Authority and Intellectual Property disclosure frameworks;
 - Relay of communications to customers;
 - Registration Data Directory Service labeling;
 - Data retention; and
 - Data escrow.



Overview: Proposed Application Process

- The ICANN organization will open an initial application window to process applications for accreditation at program launch:
 - Applications must be submitted during limited time period
 - ICANN organization will announce first accredited providers once all applications submitted during initial window have been evaluated

- Immediately after announcement of first accredited providers, program will transition to ongoing application period, similar to registrar accreditation process
- Initial processing expected to take 6+ months, depending on number of applications received
- Applications received during program maintenance phase will be processed more quickly due to lower volumes
