April 2013 LAC Strategy Steering Committee presented plan Beijing 46.

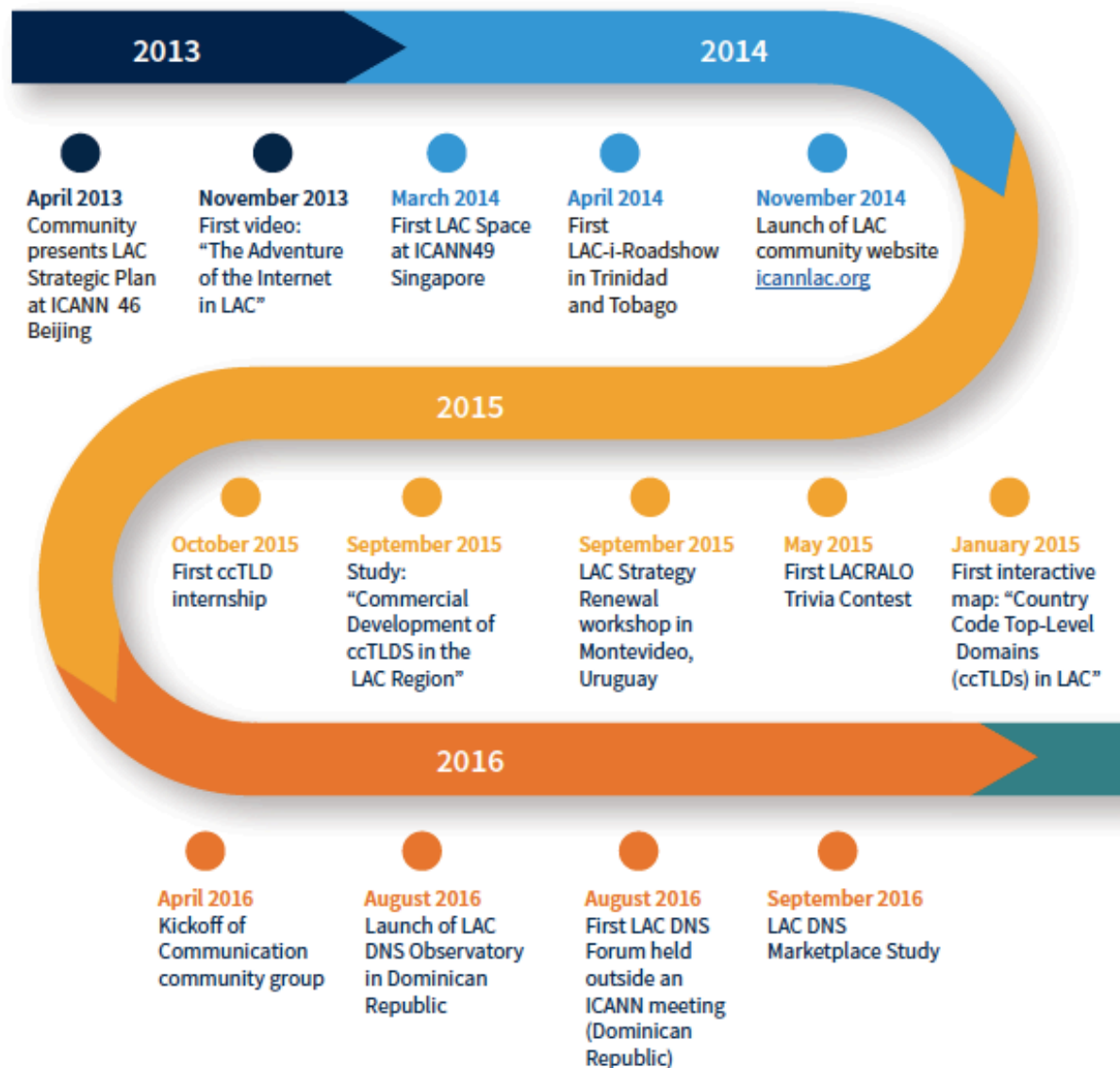

LAC DNS Observatory

The goal of the Latin America DNS Observatory is to establish a focal point for the measurement of the technical parameter of the Domain Name System (DNS) protocol in order to increase the knowledge on this critical infrastructure in the region.

Served was installed in NIC Chile's facilities

Concluded the testing phase

Official launch of the Observatory was August 2016 during the LAC DNS Forum in Dominican Republic
