- Funding cannot be used to reimburse a community group or individual member for work they perform themselves.

Internauta Argentina has been the Technical Office for Internet Day in Argentina since 2007.

In 2008, Internet Day was declared a Day of Municipal Interest by the General Pueyrredón City Council.
