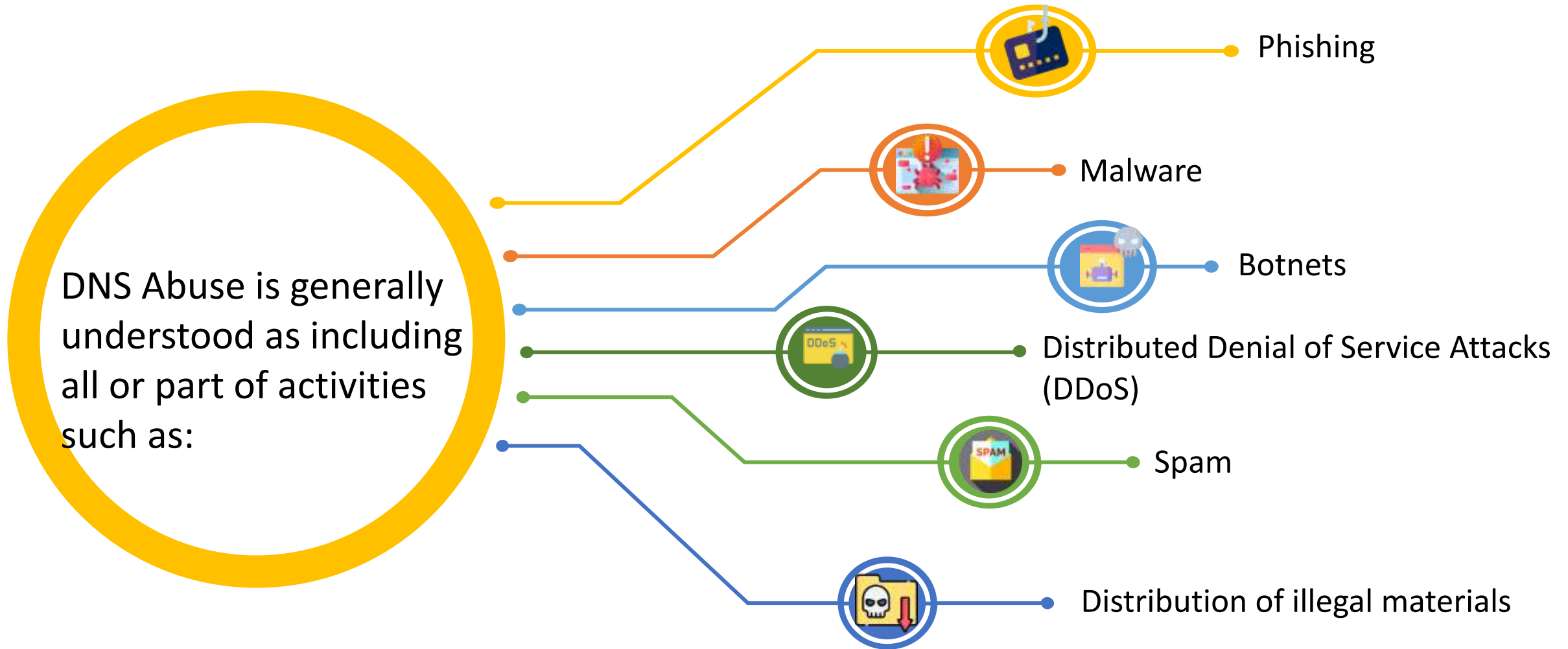

Who is responsible for which parts of the puzzle, and how can different actors best cooperate?



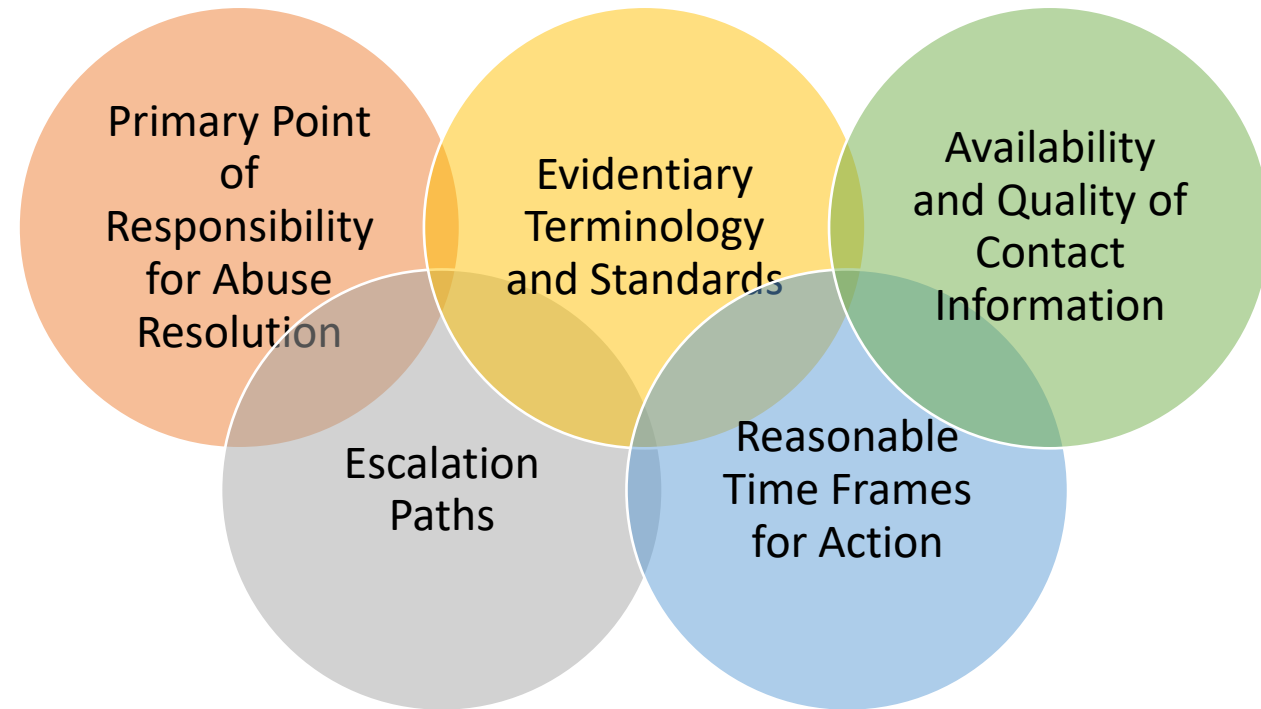
Recent Developments

Security and Stability Advisory Committee (SSAC) Report (SAC115)

General framework to addressing Abuse and best practices and processes to streamline reporting of DNS abuse

SSAC in this report examined the creation of a “**Common Abuse Response Facilitator**” to streamline abuse reporting and minimize abuse victimization.

SSR2 The Second Security, Stability, and Resiliency Review

- The SSR Review conducted frequently every five years, measured from the date the previous SSR Review Team was convened (see Bylaws, Section 4.6(c)).
- Its objective to examine how effectively ICANN is meeting its commitment to enhance the operational stability, reliability, resiliency, security and global interoperability of the systems/processes (internal/external) that affect the Internet's unique identifiers
