## Meeting notes:

- The narrator doesn't have to say exactly the same verbatim text in the scenarios.
- Abdalmonem suggested adding a popular language in Africa, Amharic in the scenario1 list. Amharic was also added to the beginning of the scenario2.
- Note to the vendor for the Scenario2 was added. "Note to vendor: This is about the guide and high-level process, NOT detailed technical how-to-do-it, pitfalls, etc."
- Abdalmonem suggested changing the wording from "EAI-ready" to "UA-ready" because UA-readiness refers to 5 key principles.

- Jim: We use the term “UA-Ready” 3 times in this document, and the term “EAI-Ready” 3 times. We should standardise on one of those terms.
- Jim: I support “EAI-ready” over “UA-Ready” because we already use the term “EAI” in the title, “EAI Self-Certification Guide”.
- Seda: Should we say in the beginning of the document as “EAI ready as per the EAI self-certification guide”? So that audience knows what it means.
- Mark noted to address it later about how to define “EAI-ready” term. “We can consider using "EAI-Ready" in some places, but it needs to be defined somewhere first.”
- Nitin’s suggested text was added to the scenario3 in the scene2 and scene3.
- Regarding the stock footage: Test results (pass/fail) were previously shared in ICANN76 (minute 26:45) however as this is not including the scoring.
